Continuing to Innovate

I've been reflecting on the many challenges our community and world have faced the past few years. I've witnessed firsthand the stress and strain that the pandemic has caused people and their pets, making our work more critical than ever.

Despite the challenges of the last few years, we remain strong. We sheltered 2,177 animals, served over 500 families through online and in-person classes for both cats and dogs, helped shelter over 900 animals transferred from over 30 other shelters, and provided 35,830 pounds of free pet food to over 1,000 households through our Pet Food Pantry.



This couldn't be possible without YOU. Because of you, our work continues to make a difference for people and their pets.

East Bay SPCA has been a leader in animal welfare since 1874. From being the first animal welfare shelter in the Bay Area to require all animals to be spayed and neutered to implementing innovative programs that match low-income East Bay residents with free and low-cost pet services, your continued support has enabled us to fill gaps that no other shelter does.

I'm grateful and humbled by all that we've accomplished this past year. It speaks to the innovative, committed, and resilient spirit of our staff, Board of Directors, volunteers, and donors. 

Bailey and Shadow Become Neighborhood Celebrities


When Kevin and Darlene came to East Bay SPCA, they had just said goodbye to their dog of 14 years. They were hoping to adopt just one dog. Instead, left our shelter with two.

"Bailey", a Pitbull, and "Shadow", a Shepard-mix, arrived as owner surrenders, having changed hands quite a few times before they reached us. Our Behavior & Training Team observed both dogs reacting towards other dogs - a huge barrier to their being adopted. Together, with the help of foster volunteers, the team taught the dogs to channel their big feelings towards something more enjoyable-like walks and play.

Kevin and Darlene had never had reactive dogs before, let alone two! They were wary of what type of work might be involved in maintaining control of two animals who at the end of a leash together total about 140 lbs. Little did they realize that less than a year later, their lives would be totally transformed by Bailey & Shadow's presence.

Kevin credits the solid framework our Behavior & Training team provided during adoption counseling as a key to the family's success building trust with the dogs. "I learned that their [Bailey & Shadow's] reactivity came from their uncertainty about what was going to happen. Slowly, we built a relationship that I'm pretty darn proud of," says Kevin.

Kevin and the dogs often walk through Joaquin Miller Park or Diamond Canyon Trail in Oakland, a feat that many would consider nerve-wracking with two reactive and very large dogs. He shares that thanks to their daily behavior and training practice, both dogs maintain a loose leash, with no pulling or straining, in order to progress on their walks. It's this structure that provides

a safety net to help both Kevin and the dogs enjoy their walks without incidents. "There isn't a whole lot in my life of which I'm especially proud, but yesterday on a narrow trail above Sausal Creek we came around a corner and were confronted by 9 off-leash dogs, all 10 lbs or less. A year ago, blood would have run in the dust, and I took a certain amount of satisfaction in knowing that I got my dogs to the point of avoiding such an outcome while giving them a chance to be out in the woods."

EXTENDING OUTREACH THROUGH NEW PARTNERSHIPS Shelter Dog Becomes Search and Rescue Star

Last February, a young pure-bred Belgian Malinois puppy, named Dodger, arrived as a late Valentine at our shelter. He wasn't a stray but rather an owner surrender. The family surrendered Dodger to East Bay SPCA with the hope that we could help him find the perfect environment to thrive.

Our Behavior & Training team immediately noticed that a shelter stay wouldn't provide enough stimulus for this smart fella. Belgian Malinois are considered "high drive dogs" — dogs that are predisposed to perform specific high-energy tasks such as herding and military work. For a young dog with these traits, such as Dodger, isolation in a shelter kennel could be detrimental to his well-being. Our mission was simple: find Dodger a job!

After Dodger's behavioral evaluation showed a predictable knack for training, we reached out to our network and the Search Dog Foundation (SDF) quite literally came to his rescue.

Nestled in the agriculture and orchards of Santa Paula, California, Search Dog Foundation partners with animal shelters across the country and identifies and trains

shelter dogs to become search-and-rescue dogs. The admissions process is comprehensive,

which means if candidates don't pass training or if the dogs become disinterested in the "job", SDF works to find the right environment for the dog. The foundation also provides a lifetime care guarantee for every dog. Once in the program, even if they get injured or retire, the Search Dog Foundation will find them a forever home.

SDF had just changed their admission guidelines to allow puppies into the program and so they gladly admitted Dodger - their first "puppy!"

Dodger not only expressed interest in his training—he excelled at it! Both animal and human candidates in SDF's training program must cross-train with each other before being paired together for their deployment into the field. Dodger impressed SDF trainers with his skills and ability. He often out-paced senior class dogs as a sophomore search dog!

Dodger was paired with Adam, a local firefighter. Adam says, "Fully grown, Dodger was practically born for this job. He excels at agility and has a blast climbing ladders, traversing elevated planks, and boldly riding the teeter-totter as it drops. There's nothing he'd rather do than search a rubble pile, though, and he's fantastic at it: finding victims quickly and wasting no time to alert with gusto!"

Caring for animals extend beyond the walls of a shelter. They require partnerships and collaboration. From rescue to rescuer, we are grateful that we were able to work together to help Dodger thrive!



VOLUNTEER SERVICES How Volunteerism Saves Lives

This past year we were reminded just how impactful a donation of time and energy can have on an organization. Our volunteers contributed over 23,000 hours in 2021 in both animal and shelter care, as well as foster roles and helping in our Behavior & Training team. Over this past year, 800 animals were fostered and this includes some of our elder or larger dogs for whom a kennel stay of any length is uncomfortable and causes severe stress.

Despite nation-wide staffing shortages due to the pandemic, we continued to serve animals without missing a beat thanks to our 700+ volunteers who stepped in to help. A huge thanks to all of you who helped us to provide care to animals in our community! We appreciate all of our volunteers and are especially thankful for our legacy volunteers who help to mentor and train our newer volunteer team members.

HUMANE ADVOCACY Keeping People And Pets Together

We believe that an animal's well-being is directly proportional to their caretaker's well-being. That is why we serve people and their pets. Our team leads the nation in humane advocacy, matching low-income East Bay residents with services and local resources - including spay/neuter, vaccines, and veterinary care. The Humane Advocacy (HA) programs at East Bay SPCA prioritize making meaningful connections and helping pet owners in our community find veterinary care, financial assistance, or social services they need when they are unsure where to turn to help their pet. Every person regardless of their housing situation, income level, race, spoken language, or access to resources should be able to experience the joys of the human-animal bond. The more programs and services we can provide, the better we can help keep families together.

Through our Humane Advocacy program, we serve the most under-resourced communities in Alameda and Contra Costa Counties in Northern California. We have Spay/Neuter Centers in Oakland and Dublin and a full-service, American Animal Hospital Association (AAHA)-accredited Veterinary Clinic in Oakland near some of the most under-resourced neighborhoods in the Bay Area that have few options for quality, affordable veterinary care. Oakland's homeless population has increased by at least 47% since 2017, and its residents have been particularly hard hit by the pandemic and resulting economic depression. There has also been a 35% increase in Contra Costa County homelessness from 2019 – 2022. Most of our applicants earn less than \$12,000/year and receive benefits such as SSI, SSDI, General Relief, and CalFresh (food stamps). Up from 12% last year, 17% of current applicants are experiencing homelessness or unstable housing and do not have income. Only 15% of applicants report being employed full time. The majority are retired, disabled, and/or unemployed. We do not turn away any pet families based on employment, housing, legal, or immigration status, so we are able to connect with and serve communities who would not otherwise be able to receive these services. In 2021, our Humane Advocacy programs supported over 1,000 pet owners.
