1. Percentage of estate

2. Specific amount

I give, devise, and bequeath to East Bay SPCA, a non-profit organization (Tax ID #94-1322202) located in Oakland, California, the sum of _____ (\$ _____), free of all estate, inheritance or other succession taxes and free of all expenses of administration, as an unrestricted gift to be used at the discretion of the Board of Directors of East Bay SPCA for its general purposes.

3. Beneficiary designation of life insurance policy, retirement plans or financial accounts
